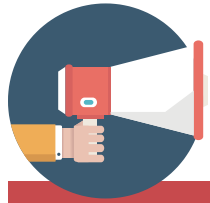

1. FAFSA is due March 2!

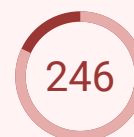
That means counselors are grabbing some seniors this coming week to sit down with them to complete this process! Please help support this effort by encouraging students and releasing them from your classroom.
