Outreach Plan in Action

As the school year moves into October, we will be using all of our resources to reach out to students who need assistance logging on and engaging in Distance Learning.

Teachers will report students who miss Zoom or other asynchronous learning and the outreach will begin from there with the help of classified staff; both clerical and campus monitor staffs will be focused on the effort.

Our goal will be to have 90% of our students successfully engaged in Distance Learning.

The process that will provide us the best chance to reach that goal of 90% engaged has begun and will continue through distance learning. Counselors and campus monitors will follow up with students identified as missing consecutive sessions, whether they are synchronous or asynchronous.

Home visits may be necessary to assess issues and needs. HJHS has computers if your need is technology, a support center if your need is emotional or traumatic and counselors if your need is guidance.

WASC visit scheduled for March 15 & 16

The Western Association of Schools and Colleges will be conducting our Mid-Cycle WASC review March 15 and 16.

The WASC visit last year prepared us for this regularly scheduled accreditation visit. The WASC review runs on 6-year cycles. The vast majority of schools receive a mid-term visit

in the 3rd year of the cycle. Last year we had a probationary visit that validated our academic plan was appropriate and being successfully implemented.

Key points of the plan submitted to WASC are: community engagement, the PDSA cycle in CT sessions, formative assessments that lead

instruction, focused counseling, and our School-Wide Learning Outcomes among others.

In the spring of 2018 the visiting WASC committee did not find evidence we were implementing the plan, which resulted in the visit last year. A successful review last year has set the school up for a great visit in March.

This coming week counselors will be in Sophomore English classes sharing important information about high school, graduation, and supports on campus. Be sure to ask your student what they learned from the presentation.

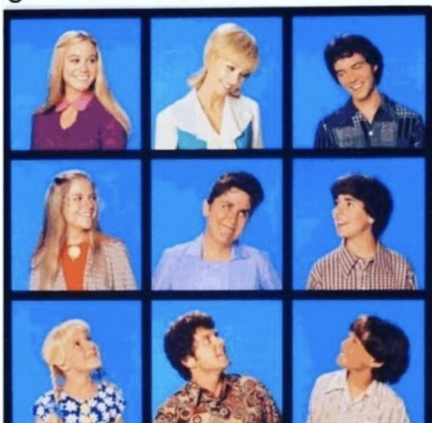
ASSETS - Expanded Learning

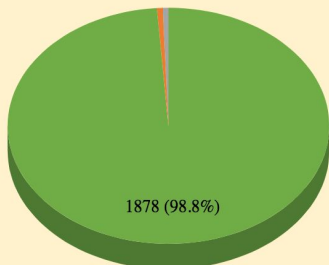

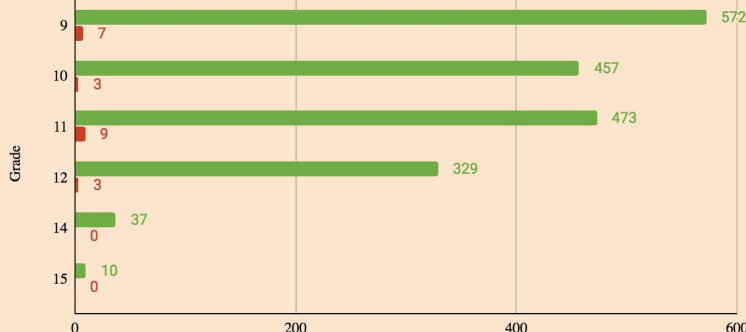
Distance Learning Participation Based Attendance from 9/21 to 9/30

Students will complete the survey in their 2nd period classes starting on Monday, Oct 5. Make-up days will be Monday, Oct. 12 and Oct. 19.

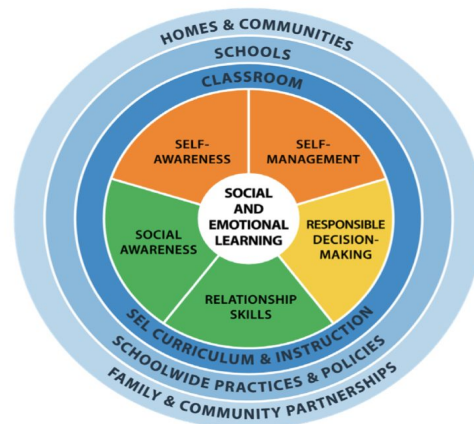


Figure 1: CASEL's Framework for Systemic SEL
