Their responses will give us the needed data to order test materials, secure proctors, and arrange classrooms to support a successful test administration.

Site plan mid-year review this month

Hiram Johnson High School will be conducting its mid-year review of the Site Plan for Student Achievement in December.

As we continue through distance learning, we must monitor what we laid out in the plan and its effectiveness. The four goals called out in the plan are:

1. Passing rate of 9th graders in IM 1 with a C or better
2. Growth rate of EL students on the ELPAC
3. Rate of College and Career readiness
4. Campus climate survey results

Each of these goals has a list of strategies or investments that need to be evaluated for effectiveness. The findings for the mid-year review allow the school site council to plan for next year.

As the School Improvement Grant is expiring at the end of the year and we continue through distance learning, how we allocate our funding may never be more important. The mid-year review will allow the school site council to monitor data for effectiveness of our strategies and spending.

While we don't have all of the data we normally would use to assess our effectiveness, it will still drive our strategies and spending.

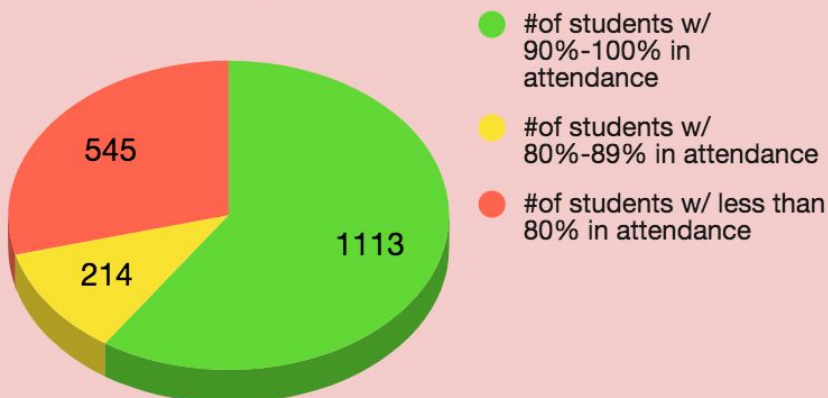
