Hate & violence response

After the shooting spree in Georgia that took the lives of eight people—including six Asian American women—it's important to pause, check in and prioritize care. Consider how colleagues and students may feel intimately connected to the lives lost this week. How to hold space for the violence in Atlanta (LiberatEd):

1. Acknowledge what happened.
2. Invite students to reflect silently or in their journals about what happened.
3. Create space for students to explore their feelings together or with a trusted adult.
4. Share [healing-centered resources](#).
5. Invite students to brainstorm solutions for addressing AAPI hate and for supporting/protecting AAPI people in their communities.
6. Ask students what they need to heal.
7. Incorporate a deep breathing exercise focused on healing.



Virtual WASC visit concluded with positive report

The Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC) completed its virtual visit of Hiram Johnson High School this week.

WASC is the governing body that determines the accreditation of high schools and the diplomas they confer to their students. The visiting team visited classrooms, attended meetings and interviewed administrators and community members.

The visiting team is charged with reviewing the site plan and previous WASC visit reports and determining whether or not the school is successfully implementing the plan and responding to previous directives.

After its visit, the team reported a growing sense of community on the campus; that the faculty, students and staff are buying in to the plan; the need to continue with professional development for staff; the need to continue to reach out to the community.

Following the successful visit, our next WASC evaluation will be in three years.

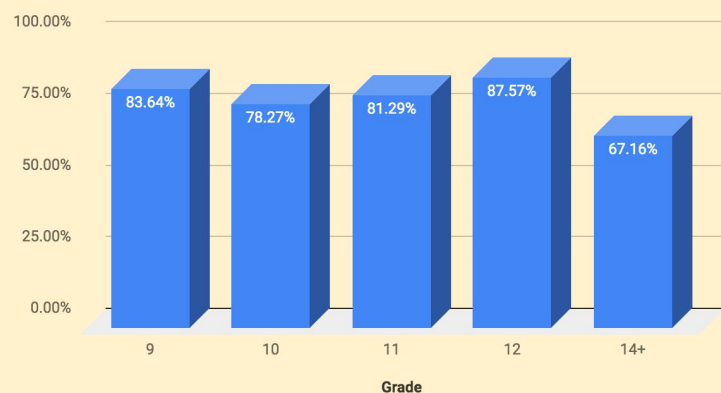

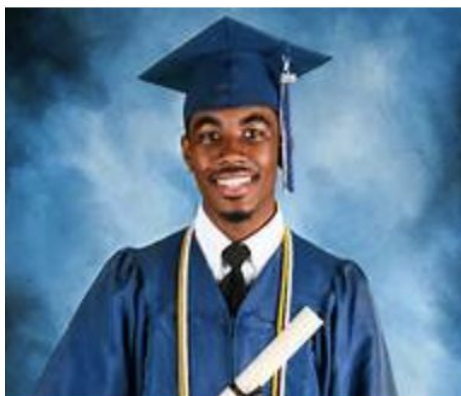

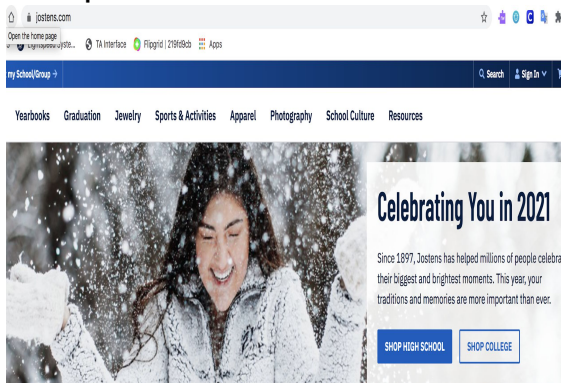
