Students allowed to return to campus on April 22

Sacramento City Unified has announced that students will be allowed to return to campus in April.

High Schools will re-open for students on Thursday, April 22. Students will be offered a choice of returning to campus or continuing distance learning.

Students will be divided into three groups. After students who will remain in distance learning are identified, the remaining students will be grouped into "A" and "B" groups.

"A" group students will be attending school on campus Tuesdays and Wednesdays. "B" group students will be attending school on campus on Thursday and Fridays. All students will have distance learning on Mondays.

Monday's schedule will be the same as it has this year. Classes on Tuesday through Friday will be changing times. There will still be only three classes each day, but they will start and begin earlier than they have so far this year.

The first class on Tuesday - Friday will begin at 9 am. The second class on those days will begin at 10:10. The third class will begin at 11:20. Students on campus will be dismissed home at 12:20.

The cafeteria will be providing take home lunches after school. Meals for students who are not returning to campus will be provided on Mondays that should last the week.

Small group instruction or other interventions could be offered by teachers after the lunch break.

Our learning hub will remain open for students who have chosen to be on campus all five days. They will be in their original learning hub room when they are not scheduled to be in their on-campus class.

Our after-school program will still be operating. They will also accommodate athletes who attend school on campus so they won't have to leave at 12:20 and then return later for practice or a game.

We will be providing more information about our return to campus and hosting public Zoom meetings to inform after Easter.
