





Meeting reactions

Allow meeting participants to communicate without interrupting by reacting with an emoji that shows on their video. Reactions disappear after 10 seconds. Participants can change their reaction skin tone in Settings.

Allow removed participants to rejoin

Allows previously removed meeting participants and webinar panelists to rejoin $\overline{[v]}$

Additionally here are a few more suggestions to help manage distracting behaviors and zoom engagement steps:

- 1. Staff Knowledge: Please add the restrictions on your zoom meetings as follows:
 - Allow students in one at a time.
 - Uncheck the option that allows students to change their names
 - Uncheck the option that allows students to unmute themselves
 - Under the option "annotations" remove the ability for students to annotate. This is how they draw on the screen.(<u>see video</u>)

Require students to authenticate themselves

- 2. Put the student in the waiting room for a conversation
- 3. If applicable give them another opportunity to improve their behavior
- 4. Contact home if the behavior does not improve and document in the contact log. (see video)
- 5. Email Mr. Charles Love and Ms. Bucio to inform the Climate office that there was a contact log entry.
- 6. Administrative Resolution
